

Founded in 1982, Calgary Immigrant Women's Association (CIWA) has grown to become the largest women-focused settlement agency in Canada. At CIWA, we provide over 60 different programs and services to meet the diverse needs of immigrant and refugee women and their families.

Our services are offered to all those who need them regardless of eligibility criteria for government funding. All clients at CIWA have access to childcare and first language support. To do this, we depend on the generosity of corporate sponsors and individual donors.

2021: A year at a glance



CIWA supported over 15,500 clients through individual and group services focused on settlement and integration, employment and language training, as well as mental health and healthy relationships among immigrant women and their families.



Our strategic collaborations resulted in 79% of our clients securing employment.



Hundreds of volunteers representing 77 countries contributed over 11,500 hours to support CIWA's work.



We supported nearly 3,500 parents, youth, seniors, and families in adjusting to a new culture during pandemic.

With the theme of this anniversary event, **Global Women: Local Changemakers**, we aim to celebrate the breadth of skills, experience and values that the women of CIWA bring into our communities. With CIWA's vision, *Empower immigrant women. Enrich Canadian society*, we strive to support our clients in overcoming hurdles through their settlement journey.

Immigration presents various settlement stressors that can challenge newcomers for several years. Women often face additional challenges in everyday life, from cultural differences and role reversal, to employment, caregiving and parenting in Canada. These stressors impact family dynamics and economic stability that can result to addictions and mental health challenges, poverty, domestic violence and social isolation.

During the pandemic, women were hit harder as a result of the economic downturn, disproportionate share of job loss, increased exposure to health risks in the workplace and additional family responsibilities due to limited childcare options and children attending school online. While many are still coping with the impact of the pandemic, current global movements are creating a lot of instability in the world.

CIWA will inevitably have many immigrant women in the coming years depending on our support. Your sponsorship and donations at the Gala will help CIWA provide gender-specific services in line with urgent needs of our clients.
